


Preparing for Lent

The season of Lent covers the forty days leading up to Holy Week and Easter. During this time we draw ever nearer to the cross with Jesus, remembering his atoning death for us, confessing our sins, and recommitting our lives to him.

We begin our Lenten journey on Ash Wednesday by remembering our mortality and confessing our sins in the light of God's grace. **We'll hold an Ash Wednesday service this year on February 17th at noon**, and you can join us either online or in-person.

Pastor Sharon will then lead us in an online time of prayer each Wednesday throughout Lent. Those who want to dig deeper are encouraged to read [*A Way Other Than Our Own*](#) by Walter Brueggemann, which includes daily readings for this season. Our Wednesday prayer times will take inspiration from this book.

Be prepared for Communion this Sunday—Set aside some bread/crackers and juice/wine so that you can participate.


