God's New Thing

This week at an online pastors' conference, I heard Pastor Darrell Griffin, of Oakdale Covenant Church, speak on Isaiah 43:19, "*See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.*" Early in the pandemic, he panicked and asked himself, will this be the demise of Oakdale Covenant Church? Eventually he moved from paralyzing fear to finding possibilities and opportunities amid the crisis. He reminded us that though almost no one likes to change, in times like these we are forced to adapt. "We don't change when we see the light; we change when we feel the heat." It reminded me of what Evangelical Covenant Church President John Wenrich has said, "You can't have growth without change, and you can't have change without pain." Just because we dislike and resist change, does not mean it is all bad; often, change is necessary for health and growth. So, what new thing is God doing in you and in our church? How is God making a way in the wilderness? What good is God bringing out of this season? Can you see it? Are you looking for it?

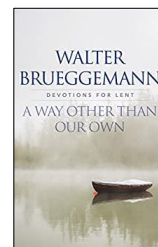
