All Hallow's Eve

In some churches, saints are remembered on All Saints' Day on November 1, while deceased loved ones are remembered on All Soul's Day (or Day of the Dead in Mexico) on November 2. Halloween was originally All Hallow's Eve—the night before All Saint's Day. In the Evangelical Covenant Church, we combine days, and in early November we have a special time of prayer during Communion, remembering loved ones who have passed away. **All Saints' Sunday is November 7.** If you have lost a loved one within the last year, you can send a picture to Pastor Chris by October 31 (digital preferred, but hard copy is ok, too). Our prayers will include all those we've lost, no matter how long ago, but our slide show will focus on those who have died since All Saint's Day in 2020.

Martin Luther, German monk turned reformer, said that all Christians are, "simultaneously saint and sinner." We are saints not because we are perfect, but because we are sinners who have been forgiven and made new in Christ. Some of our loved ones displayed obvious faith and set wonderful examples for us; others not as much. All were sinners, and we remember all of them in light of God's great mercy and with the hope of eternal life. -Pastor Sharon
