As I write this, it's the 10th day of Christmas. Thankfully, I see no "lords a leaping." The Valentine's Day section is up and running in the stores, and most of the world is ready to move on from Christmas. But let's linger just a bit longer. The shepherds were near enough to visit Jesus soon after his birth, but the Magi had a long and difficult journey to visit the newborn king. What a surprise it must have been to Mary and Joseph to be visited by these learned men from so far away. These sojourners discovered the new king from interpreting the stars in their own traditions. Think of all the different ways that God can communicate, often through his creation.
