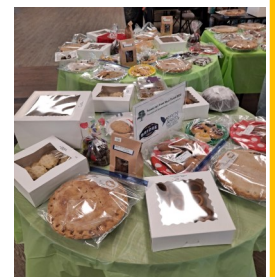
The **Sunday School kids** will play bells in church on Sunday, October 12.
