March 19 Board Meeting Recap

- Feb Income/Expenses: \$7,378 / \$9,780
- Reviewed three well quotes and voted unanimously to go with Sweeney: Total cost may be \$25,000, but will hopefully be less depending on how deep they have to drill to find good water. Building Fund money will be used for this project, but decided to invite the congregation to offset those costs.
- Board members are contesting fire dues with the Town of Sugar Creek, as the square footage of the parish house is greatly overstated.
- Approved transfer of approximately \$50,000 of unspecified memorial funds to be used for general fund expenses.
- Plans for volunteers to work on summer weeding and pest control, lowering monthly bills
- Began discussing the recipient of the money raised from Treasures From Your Trunk (May 9)
- Detailed financial reports and meeting minutes on the Fellowship Hall bulletin board
